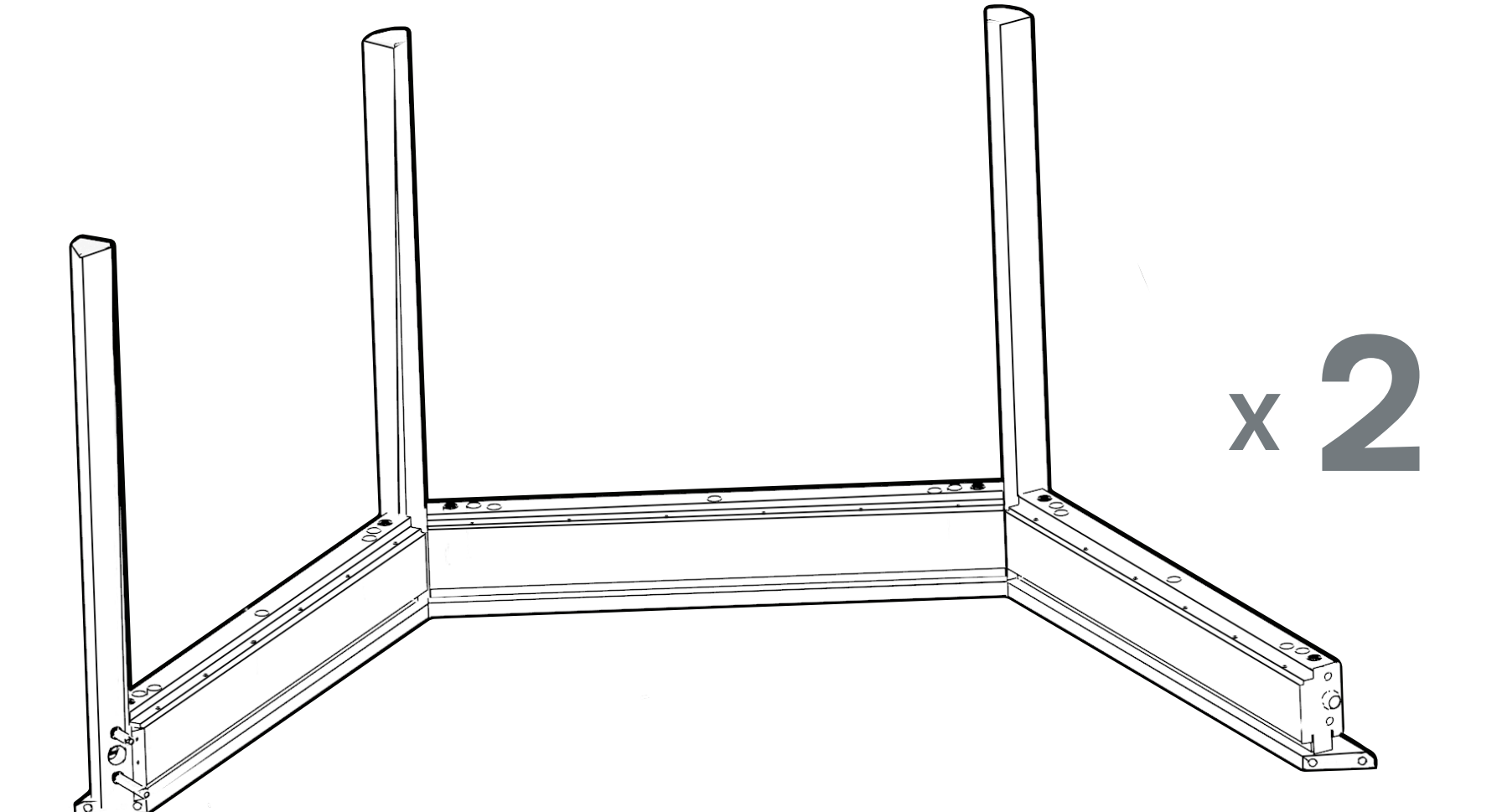
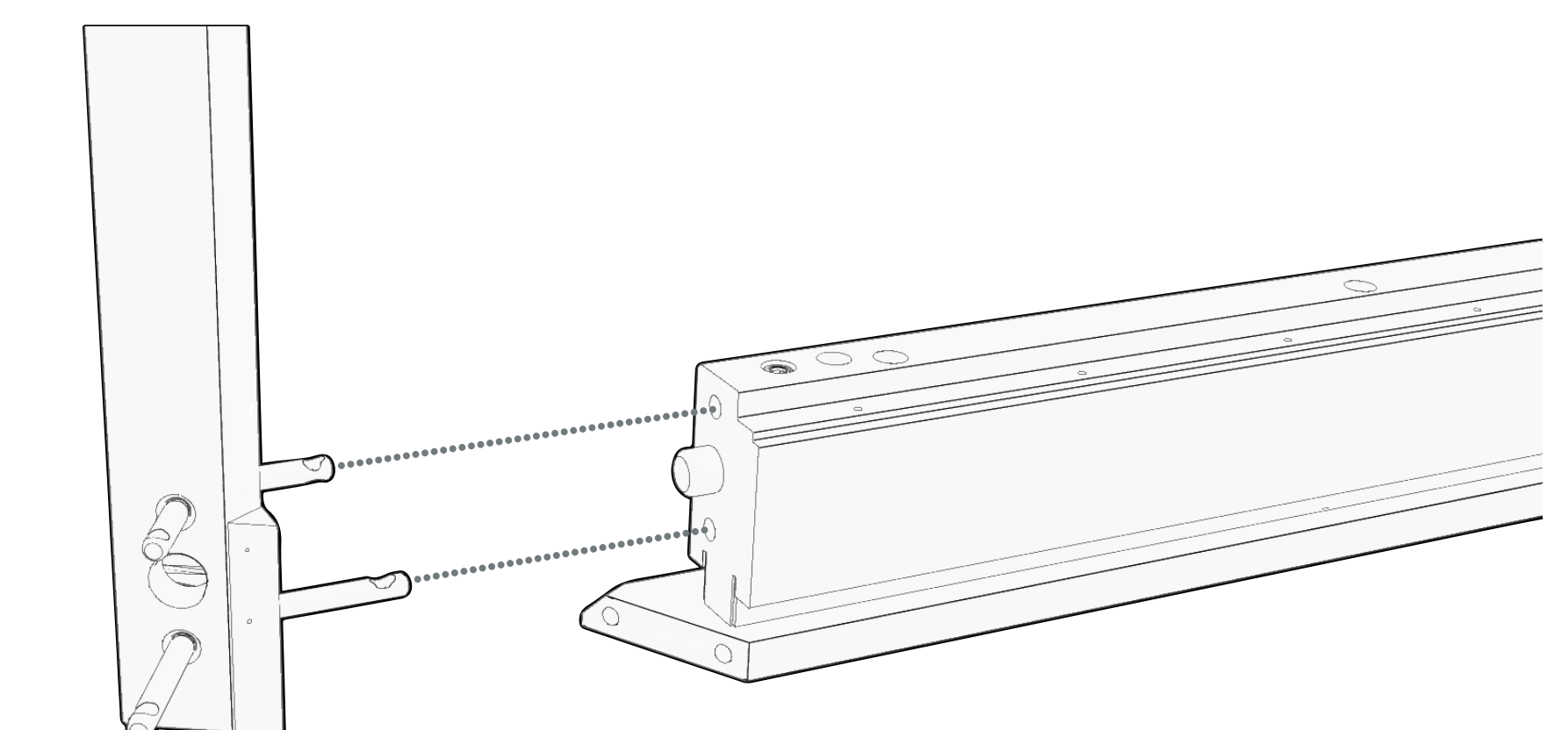
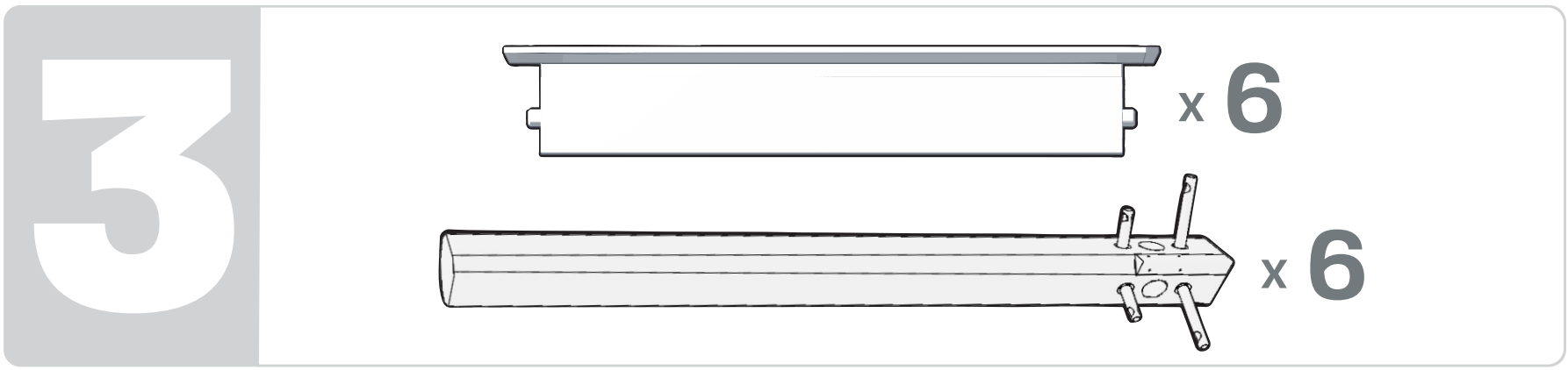


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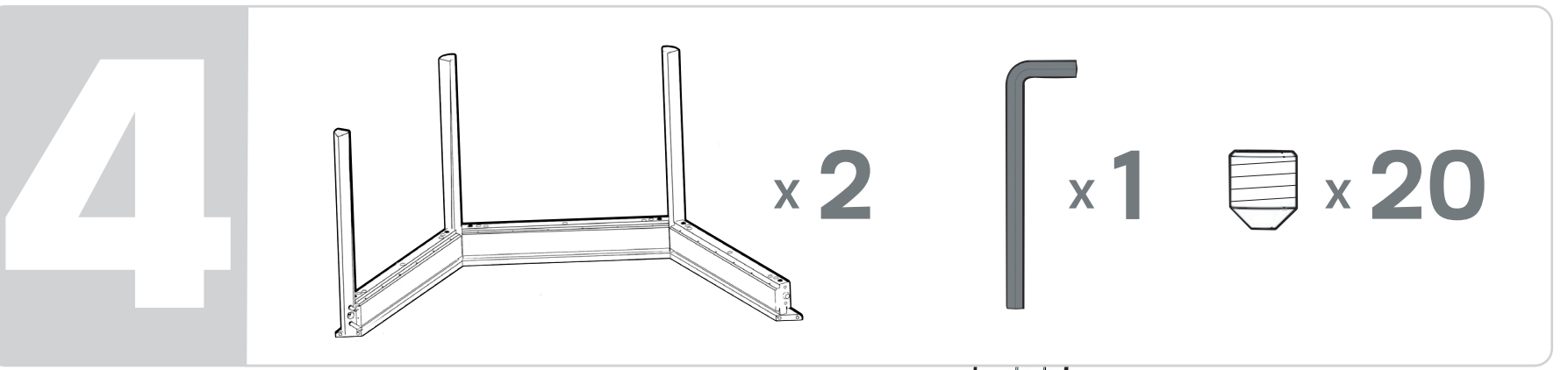
Tighten and then loosen the post rods until the divots are facing up. Use the included Hardware Template to determine how far the posts should protrude from the leg.



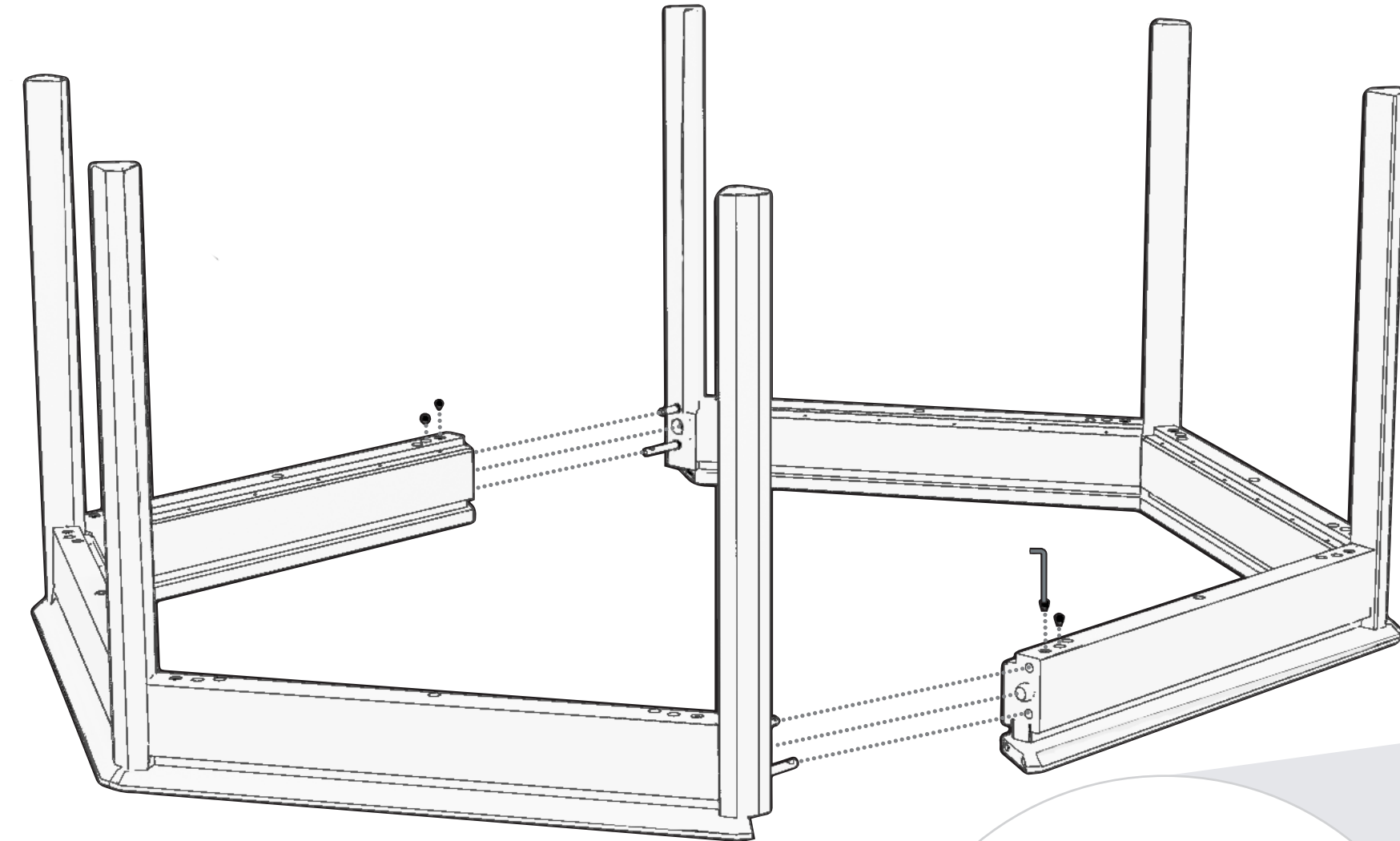
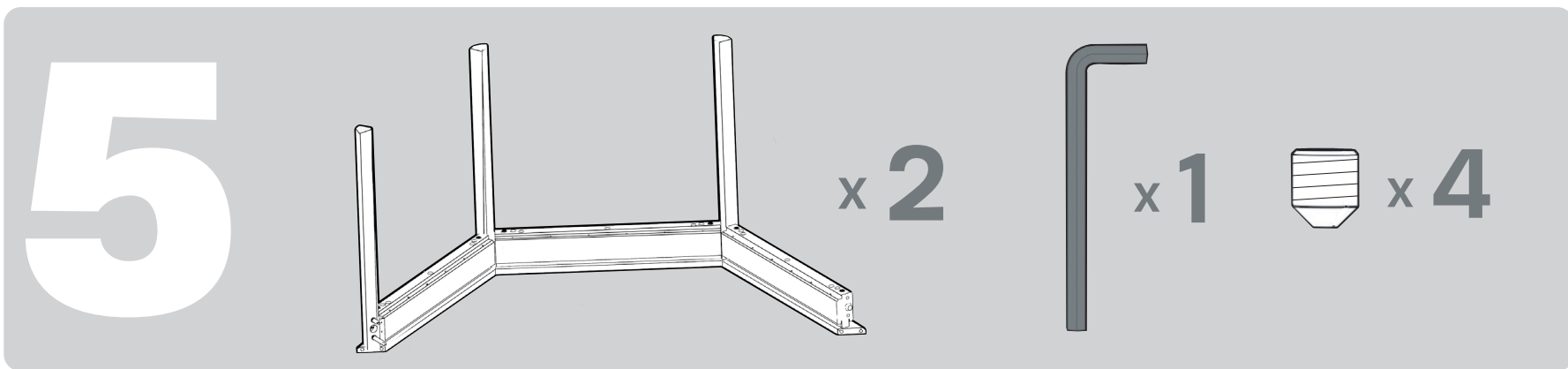
! Repeat for all six of the Side Aprons



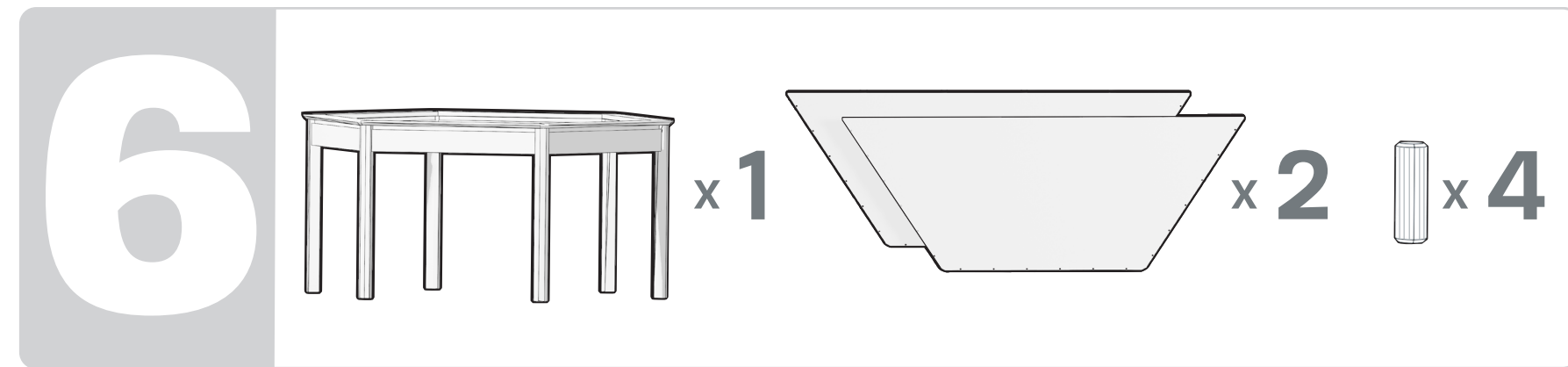
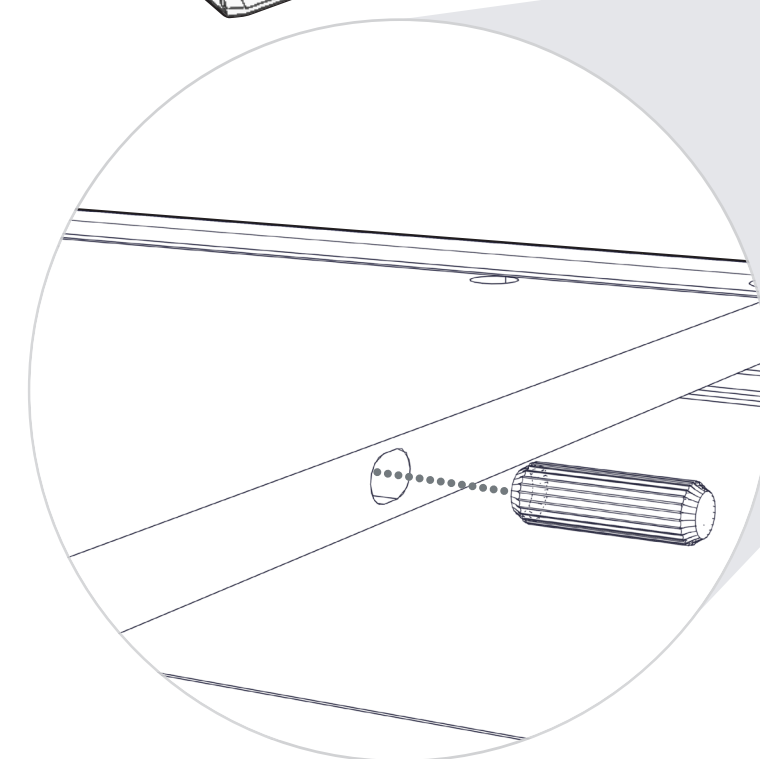
! Assemble two identical halves before moving to the next step



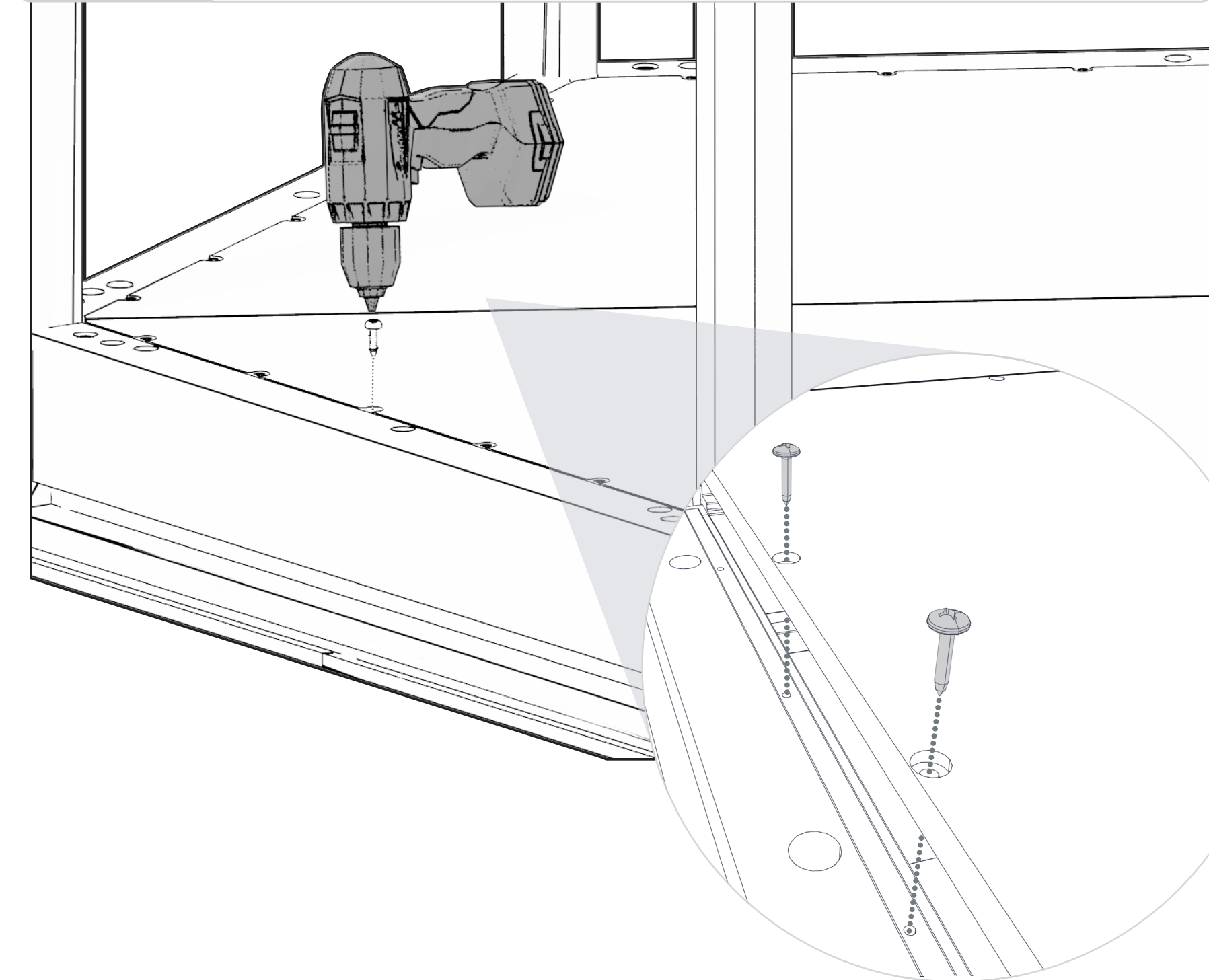
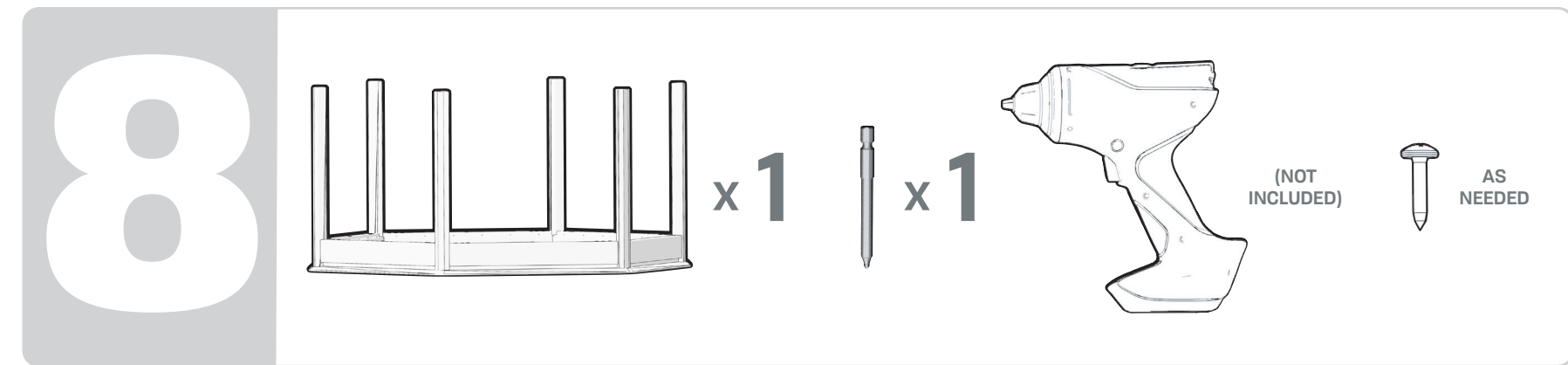
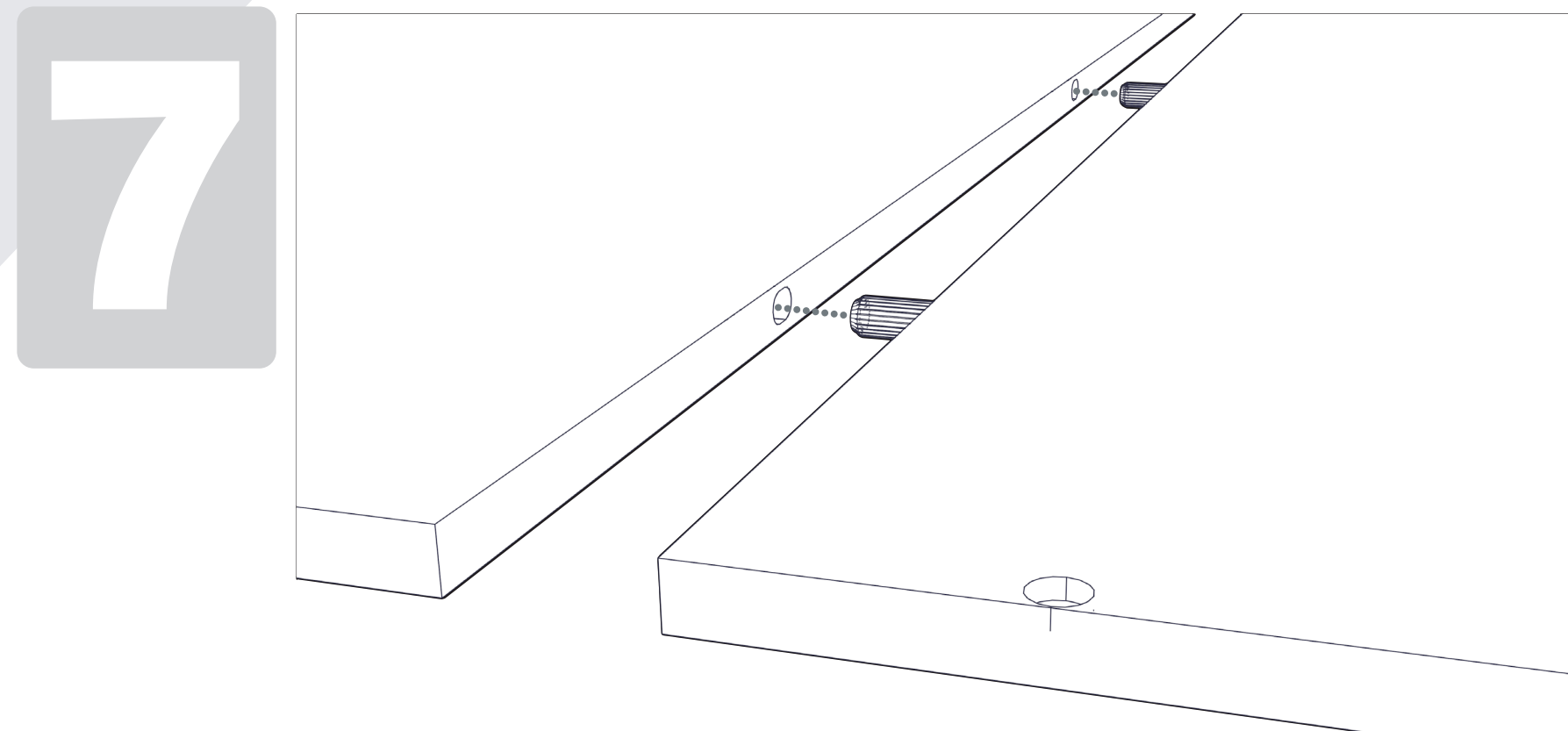
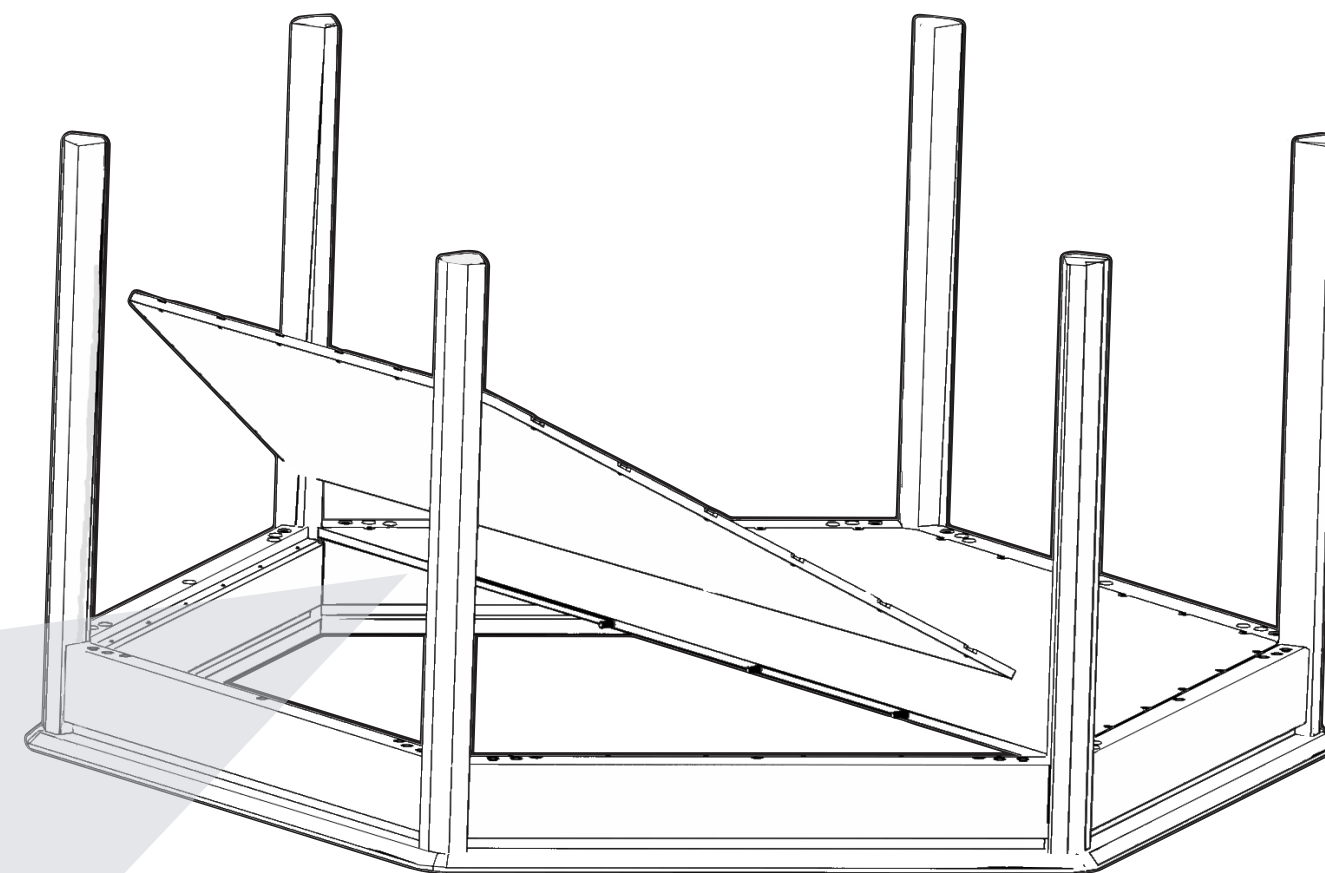
! Don't overtighten Grub Screws. Keep joints loose to ensure a snug fit during the next step.



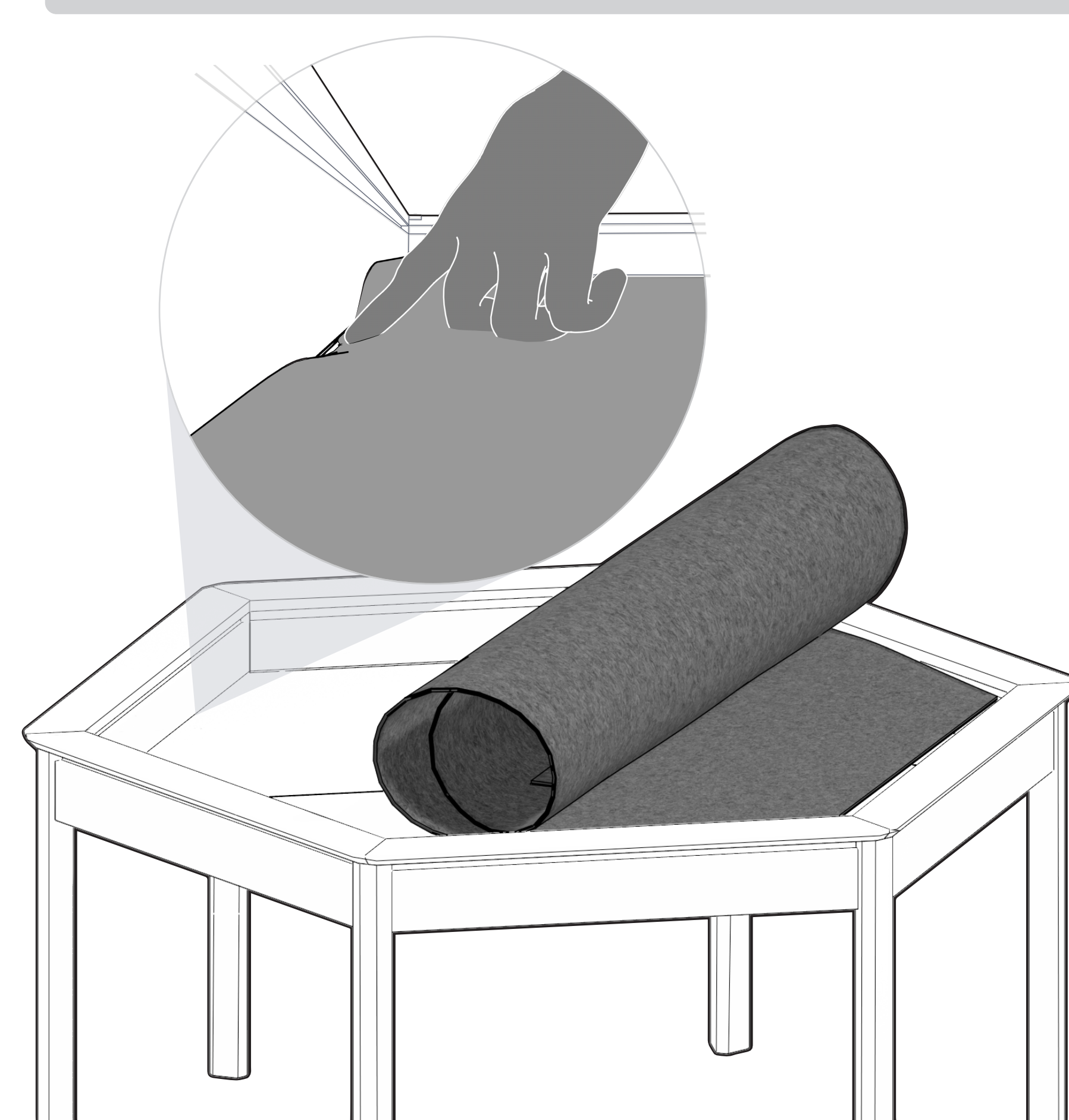
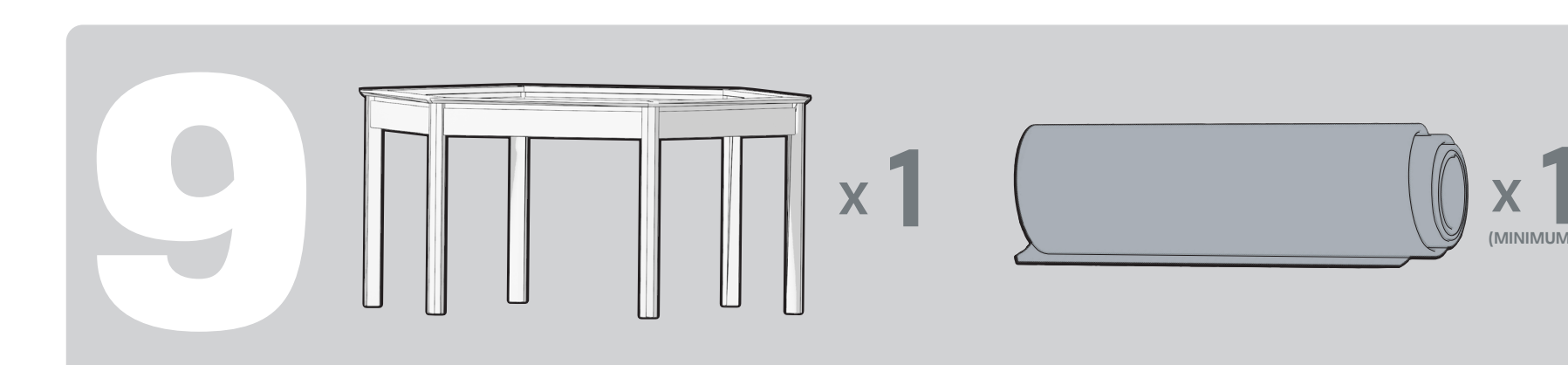
! Tighten all the Grub Screws after fitting the two halves together.




! Ensure each Plywood Panel is placed into the Table Frame with countersinks facing up

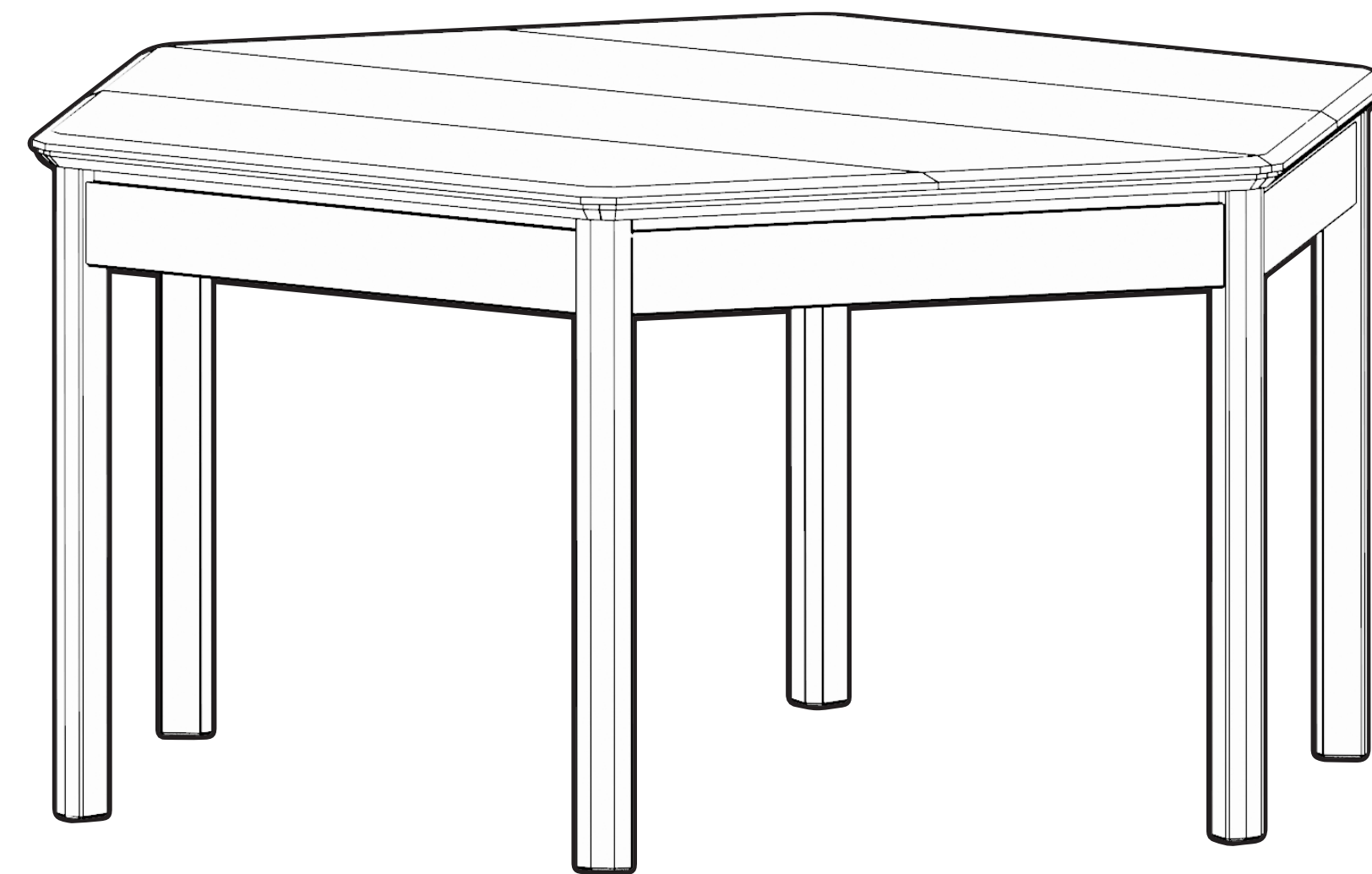


! To avoid damaging the plywood, **avoid overdrilling wood screws.** Use pilot holes as a guide when drilling, but it's okay if they're not perfectly aligned.
